Prepare a basic session plan that provides a guide for the way in which the session will progress.

For example, you could include:

- · How will you start the session?
- Which challenge questions will you ask the group?
- · How long will each challenge take?
- · How will you wrap up the session?

Keep it simple and no longer than 1 page.

The video:

Select a group of between 3-5 people, prepare your bricks and the questions you will use in the session and capture 5x 2 minute ou 10x 1 minute extracts of yourself facilitating the session.

The people present in the facilitation session can be your friends and family, assure that you have their permission to shoot the videos. The bricks don't need to be official LEGO® SERIOUS PLAY® sets.
